High Nook Tenants and Residents Association (TARA) worked with Rotherham Borough Council to provide play equipment on open green space at High Nook Road.

However, following completion, local residents reported anti-social behaviour from youngsters using their gardens as short-cuts to reach the play area.

We did!

The TARA secured funding to erect fencing to the boundary of the play area. 2010 Rotherham worked with the police, TARA members and Rotherham Wardens to cut back shrubs and trees, remove rubbish and improve the area.

You said...

As a result of residents' concerns, the Hepworth Drive area of Aston has been designated as a priority for the Partners and Communities Together (PACT) group.

We did!

As part of ongoing actions in the area, 2010 Rotherham, the Safer Neighbourhood Team, Area Partnership, Streetpride and members organised a SmartWater event. Residents were offered the SmartWater kits by staff, and a record 97 households in the area accepted. Vulnerable property was marked with the SmartWater, which is proven to reduce the risk of burglary and theft.
